Note	On the basis of the findings of the Enquiry Committee constituted in pursuance of Resolution No. (6) of the 298th Meeting of the Executive Council, D.U. held on 30.12.2009, 02 (two) annual increments of Dr. S.K. Ghosh, Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, D.U. were withheld w.e.f. 11th February, 2010 vide Office Order No. DU/Estt-A/TP/615/86/545, dated 11.02.2010. Note	Mr. Prakalpa Ranjan Bhagawati was appointed as the Publication Officer vide Order No. DU/Esstt-A/OP/2007/1446/3746, dtd. 03.07.2012 on purely contract basis in the newly instituted Publicaction Division of the University on a consolidated salary of Rs. 30,000/- p.m. (Rupees Thirty thousand) only. Considering his sincere service in the Publicaction Division as a Publication Officer, the post may perhaps be regularized only after creation of the post by the competent authority of the University as well as with due approval from the Government of Assam.
	The application submitted by Mr. Prakalpa Ranjan Bhagawati, Publication Officer (Contractual) is placed before the Council for perusal and necessary action.

Item 10	To examine the replies of Smt. Deepali Phukan, University Engineer, to the charges brought against her by the Inquiry Committees related to the alleged illegal claim of reimbursement based on the alleged forged and fake invoice bills and false claim of Earth Fillings Works around the DUIET buildings, as directed by the 320th Meeting of the Executive Council, D.U. held on 13 August, 2013.
Note	As approved by the then Vice-Chancellor, 2 (two) Inquiry Committees were constituted to ascertain the alleged fraudulent act of the University Engineer on submission of false vouchers against claimed reimbursement of expenditure incurred by the University for repairing and maintenance of various civil, sanitary, water supply and electrical works of the University and also to inquire into the allegation that payments were made for the works "Developing and Raising of Land for the proposed construction of Hostel Building for DUIET (2 Nos.)" without completion of the works vide No. DU/RG/H.01.03/13/8963, dated 09.04.2013 and vide No. DU/RG/H.01.03/13/8964, dated 12.04.2013, respectively. The Committees were requested to verify all the relevant documents submitted by the University Engineer against the advances drawn by her for the rapairing and maintenance works and also to inspect the site(s) and interrogate officials / persons connected with the work(s) to find out the truth.

The findings of the said Committees were placed before the 319<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council, D.U. held on 06 May, 2013. The Council accepted the same and authorized the Vice-Chancellor to consider approval of the charges to be framed on the basis of the findings of the Inquiry Committees and directed the Registrar to serve the charge sheets to the University Engineer. Accordingly, charge notices were served to the University Engineer, D.U. vide No. DU/RG/H.01.04/13/9024-25, dtd. 31.05.2013.

The replies of the University Engineer, D.U. against the Charge Sheet notices served on her as per decision of the Executive Council in its 319<sup>th</sup> Meeting held on 06.05.2013 were placed in the **320<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council, D.U. held on 13 August, 2013.** The Members of the Council examined the replies given by Smt. Deepali Phukan, University Engineer against the Charge Sheet notices served on her and opined that the University administration should prepare point-wise observations on her responses raised so that a proper decision can be taken by the Council in this regard.

Accordingly, the Secretary placed before the Council the point-wise observations prepared by the University adminstration against the replies submitted by Smt. Deepali Phukan, University Engineer, D.U. against the charges leveled against her.

The 322<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Executive Council held on 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2014 discussed the matter very seriously and observed that for proper investigation of both the irregularities committed, an Inquiry Committee be constituted comprising members from the technical background and legal background. The Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor to constitute the Committee.

The Inquiry Committee constituted vide No. DU/RG/H.01.04/14/0863, dtd. 24.12.2014 has conducted the inquiry into the charges levelled against Smt. Phukan and submitted their reports. The reports of Committee have already been sent to the Hon'ble Members of the Council for perusal vide letter No. DU/RG/A02.03/16/1585, dtd. 12.07.2016.

The 330th Meeting of the Executive Council held on 27 June, 2016 directed to serve notice to Smt. Phukan asking as to why the University should not accept the reports of the Inquiry Committees instituted by the University to inquire into the alleged charges brought against her.

The 331st Meeting of the Executive Council held on 27 July, 2016 directed Smt. Phukan to submit the responses to the charges brought against her by the Inquiry Committees within the extended deadline.

Accordingly, the replies furnished by Smt. Phukan have already been sent to the members of the Council for perusal and necessary action vide No. DU/RG/A.02.03/16/1754, dated 06.09.2016.

Resolved that the report of the Inquiry Committee constituted vide No. DU/RG/H.01.04/14/0863, dated 24.12.2014 be accepted.

Resolved further that on the basis of the findings of the report of the Inquiry Committee constituted vide No. DU/RG/H.01.04/14/0863, dated 24.12.2014, the penalty of **removal** from services of the Dibrugarh University be imposed on Smt. Deepali Phukan, University Engineer under the provision of Article 32(vi)(h) of the Dibrugarh University Employees' Service Conditions Ordinance, 2000 (as amended upto May, 2007) with immediate effect.

Resolved further that an Enquiry Committee be instituted to find out the deficiency of the Finance & Accounts Branch including the role of the Internal Auditor of the University while passing the bills.

## Item 11

To examine the replies of Sri Rajib Kr. Baruah, Section Officer, Accounts 'C', Dibrugarh University to the charges brought against him by the Inquiry Committees regarding allegation of fraudulent acts committed by him.

#### Note

An Internal Fact Finding Committee was constituted vide No. DU/RG/H.01.03/14/060, dtd. 07.02.2014 to inquire into the allegation of fraudulent acts committed by Sri Rajib Kr. Baruah, Section Officer, Accounts 'C' [under suspension], Dibrugarh University which was placed in the meeting of the Executive Council, held on 10.06.2014. The Council discussed the report and

authorized the Vice-Chancellor for initiating further necessary action.

As directed, a Charge Sheet Notice was served upon Sri Rajib Kr. Baruah for the allegations leveled against him. Accordingly, Sri Baruah submitted his written statement in response to the said Charge Sheet. Further, the Council apprised that the reply furnished by Sri Rajib Kr. Baruah, Section Officer, Accounts 'C' [under suspension], Dibrugarh University against the charges brought against him was not convincing and therefore a 3-Member Inquiry Committee was instituted as per the provision of the D.U. Rules and Regulations (vide No. DU/RG/H.01.03/14/0824, dated 08.12.2014) to examine the matter thoroughly.

The report of the 3-Member Inquiry Committee comprising of Smt. Krishna Gohain, IAS, Registrar, AAU, Jorhat; Sri Arup Phukan, Advocate, Dibrugarh and Sri Kumarjit Dutta, Deputy Registrar (F&A), Tezpur University was placed in the meeting. Subsequently, as Smt. Krishna Gohain, IAS expressed her inability to attend the Inquiry Committee for her new posting at Dispur as the Secretary, Government of Assam, Sri Satyabrata Sarmah, Advocate was assigned the responsibilities as the Chairperson of the Committee.

The Committee, having completed its inquiry, submitted its report which was placed in the 330<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Council held on 27 June, 2016.

The 330th Meeting of the Executive Council held on 27 June, 2016 directed to serve notice to Mr. Rajib Baruah asking as to why the University should not accept the reports of the Inquiry Committees instituted by the University to inquire into the alleged charges brought against him.

The 331st Meeting of the Executive Council held on 27 July, 2016 directed to submit the responses to the charges brought against him by the Inquiry Committees for consideration of the Council.

Accordingly, the replies furnished by Mr. Baruah had already been sent to the members of the Council for perusal and necessary action vide No. DU/RG/A.02.03/16/1754, dated 06.09.2016.

Note	As approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dibrugarh University, a 3 (three) member Inspection Team was constituted to visit North Bank College, P.O. Ghilamara, Dist. Lakhimpur for the purpose of extension of permission to introduce Major in Geology in the B.Sc. Programme w.e.f. the academic session 2016-2017. The Inspection Team reported that the college was permitted to introduce Geology as a subject w.e.f. the academic session 2010-2011 by the University, but due to its failure to recruit qualified teachers and considering poor response from the students, the enrolment of students in the subject was not possible.
	However, the college has recently recruited 3 (three) teachers in Geology and also 19 (nineteen) students have been admitted to the Geology Major course from the current academic session. The college has been trying to establish a departmental laboratory in Geology with the help of the teachers.
	Meanwhile, a show cause notice was served on the college vide letter No. DU/DCDC/16/Notice/NBC/9443, dated 18.08.2016 asking them to reply as to why appropriate actions shall not be initiated by the University against the college for not obtaining prior approval before introducing Major course in Geology thereby committing gross violation of the laid down rules and lapses on part of the college, to which the Principal had apologized for the same and prayed for condoning the lapses considering the backwardness of the region and also the future of the students who have already got admitted to the course.
	Considering all aspects, the Inspection Team recommended the University that the North Bank College be permitted to start provisionally Major in Geology in B.Sc. Programme w.e.f. the academic session 2016-2017 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. (The report is placed before the Council for perusal and to consider approval.)
	The Members of the Council discussed the matter seriously and decided to resolve as follows –
