The centre was established in 2008 having financial aid from UGC's 12 Five Year plan with a sole motive to address the issue of equity and access to the SC/ST and Minority students by preparing them for NET/JRF conducted by UGC and CSIR. It started in the academic session 2008-2009.

The centre since its inception has been arranging coaching programmes for both UGC and CSIR - NET/JRF in the following subjects.

(18) Juridical Sciences (19) Geography.

The centre has procured a good number of books on the relevant topics. It provides sample question papers, organises mock tests and offers skill based trainings to assist the students. Primarily meant for the S.C/S.T and Minority students the centre however allows the students of the general category to enrol into the programmes.
