It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that applications in Computer Generated Examination Forms are invited from the colleges for eligible candidates for admission into the **B. A. / B. Sc. / B. Com. 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Semester (Non CBCS) Examinations, 2020** to be held in the month of March - April, 2021. The hard copy of the Computer Generated Examination Forms will be issued to all colleges **from 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2021** onwards which are to be collected from the EDPS Section of the University. The soft copy of the Excel sheet containing the list of candidates along with the other details shall be available in the University website [www.dibru.ac.in](http://www.dibru.ac.in)

The last date for submission of filled in Examination Forms of the candidates along with the soft copies and requisite fees in the University is **23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2021 (without late fine) and 25<sup>th</sup> February 2021 (with late fine)** without fail. **Incomplete forms, Excel sheets without marking 'Y' or 'N' in the 'App' column, Elective Paper Codes, forms without fee and forms received after the last date will be rejected straightway and no correspondence will be entertained in this behalf. Colleges are requested to submit the Examination Forms well ahead of the last date in order to avoid the last minute rush and inconvenience.**

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**


- Colleges are requested to submit the **big size detail statement of fees** in the order so that similar kind of fees paid by the candidates should be clubbed together. This is especially required to expedite the process of checking the statements manually without any hassle.
- The Admit cards and other relevant documents pertaining to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Semester B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. (Non CBCS) Examinations shall be downloaded from **3<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021**. As such the colleges are requested to visit the University website ([www.dibru.ac.in](http://www.dibru.ac.in)) or contact the EDPS Section for any update at the mail id [sadiq@dibru.ac.in](mailto:sadiq@dibru.ac.in)
- The colleges that have not deposited the affiliation fees / permission fees, annual affiliation fee of the sports board and fees for section permission etc. to the University are requested to clear the outstanding fees before submission of Examination forms and fees. Please ignore the same if already paid. For details, the concerned colleges may contact the office of the Director, College Development Council.
- The Examination Fees should be deposited in the form of Bank Draft drawn in favour of the Registrar, Dibrugarh University payable at **Punjab National Bank, Dibrugarh University Branch** or through RTGS (A/C No. 0157002100032540, IFSC Code: PUNB0994000, MICR Code: 786024003) and a receipt confirming the payment should be taken from the Finance and Accounts Branch of the University.
- Complying Office Memorandum No. AHE.639/2018/16 Dated, Dispur the 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2020, the examination fee for the Academic Session 2020 – 2021 of all students (domicile from Assam) studying only at various Govt./Provincialised (under Directorate of Higher Education) Colleges**



and Institutes under the territorial jurisdiction of Dibrugarh University are hereby waived off. However, the benefit of fee waiver will not include non govt. / non provincialised Colleges / Institutes and the self – financing courses of the Colleges / Institutes.


6. During the course of submission of Examination form at the EDPS section of the Examination Branch, D. U. , the Principals of the Colleges are requested to submit a consolidated list of fee waived beneficiaries in excel format (both hard and soft copies). The excel file should contain (i) Sl No, (ii) Name of candidates, (iii) Programme (BA/B.Sc/B.Com), (iv) Branch (Major/General/Specialty), (v) Examination fee waived (in Rs.), (vi) Marksheet fee waived (in Rs.), (vii) Non-Collegiate fee waived (in Rs.), (viii) Late fine fee waived (in Rs.) and (ix) total amount waived (in Rs.) at the bottom of the sheet.
7. For any queries related to the hard copy of the Examination Forms and the Excel sheet, the EDPS Section of Dibrugarh University may be contacted.
8. All the Principals of the Colleges are requested to inform the examinees well ahead so that no one is left out from the process of filling up the examination form within the last date. They should take special care so that the eligible candidates that have deposited the examination fee have signed on the examination form too. The University shall not accept examination forms from individual candidates and as such colleges should not forward/request the University in this regard.
