B.Ed. COMMON ENTRANCE TEST (B.Ed. CET) 2021

for admission to

THE NCTE RECOGNIZED B.Ed. PROGRAMME

Online applications are invited from eligible candidates for appearing in the **B.Ed. Common Entrance Test (B.Ed. CET) 2021** for admission to the B.Ed. Programme under Dibrugarh University scheduled to be held on **19.09.2021 (Sunday)**.

A. Eligibility Criteria for Admission

- (a) Candidate with at least 50% marks (in Aggregate) either in the Bachelor's Degree and /or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/ Social Sciences/ Humanities; OR Bachelor's in Engineering / Technology of Dibrugarh University, or any other University recognized by Dibrugarh University with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.
- ** A candidate securing 50% marks or more in the Honours / Major subject but less than 50% in aggregate in all the courses / papers of the Bachelor's degree will not be eligible for admission to B.Ed. programme, as the requirement is 50% marks in the aggregate.
- (b) Candidate must clear the B.Ed. Common Entrance Test conducted by the University for that academic session.

B. Reservation

- (a) There will be statutory reservation under various categories as follows:
 - > SC 7%
 - > ST (P) 10%
 - > ST (H) 5%
 - ➤ OBC/MOBC 15%
 - ➤ Differently abled 3% (candidates who are very negligibly disabled by visual deficiency and the like, shall not be eligible for consideration under this reserved category)
 - > EWS-10% of the total seats over and above the intake capacity

C. Relaxation

Relaxation of marks upto 5% in the qualifying examinations may be granted to the following candidates:

- (a) Candidates belonging to the SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/PWD categories,
- (b) Teacher candidates with minimum of five years teaching experience in a school recognized up to 10th standard by the Board of Secondary Education, Assam.
- (c) A candidate can avail the benefit of relaxation of marks only in any one of the above categories.

D. Application Procedure for the B.Ed. CET 2021

- 1. Online Registration for submission of Application Form will begin from <u>23.08.2021</u>. Application for B.Ed. CET 2021 is through online mode only. No other means of application is accepted. The last date for submission of application is <u>05.09.2021 (till 5.00 p.m.)</u>
- 2. For submission of the *Online Application Form*, intending candidates are advised to follow the following instructions:
 - a) The candidate shall be required to visit the B.Ed. CET 2021 Portal in the website-www.dibru.ac.in and go through the 'Click here to Apply' Link.
 - b) The Candidates are suggested to read carefully the Process-flow or the Instructions before going to the Next step.
 - c) On clicking the *Next* button, the Online Application Form shall be displayed. The Candidates need to fill-up all information correctly. Please note that all fields of the Application Form are mandatory.
 - d) During filling-up the Application Form, the Candidate need to create a *Password* according to their choice for subsequent log-in to pay *Application Fee* and *Final Submission*.
 - e) After completion of the filling-up the Form and uploading of the Photograph and Signature, the Candidate needs to click the button- 'Submit and Proceed for Payment of the Application Fee' of Rs.700/- only.
 - f) In the next page, the candidate needs to log-in by entering the *Mobile No.* and *Password* for Fee Payment.
 - g) On Payment of the Fees, 'Your Final Submission is done. You may take print out of your Application Form and Admit Card now' will be displayed.
 - **h**) There will be a button to download your Application Form and Admit Card for future reference.
 - i) The Candidate shall have to take a print out of the Admit Card and bring the same to the Examination Hall on the Date of the Test for verification.
 - *j*) The Submission of Online Application Forms shall be automatically closed after the last date.
- 3. There shall be no alternative procedure for Application for applying to the B.Ed. CET 2021 and the University shall not receive the Application except the procedure mentioned at (2) above.

Important Note: The University shall not verify the eligibility of a candidate at the time of receiving their Application Forms and Issuing Admit Card to them. The candidates not fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria shall not be debarred from appearing the B.Ed. CET, 2021.

However, their candidature shall not be considered at the time of admission to the B.Ed. Programes conducted by Dibrugarh University and its affiliated colleges. Hence, the intending candidates are requested to ensure themselves regarding fulfillment of the minimum eligibility for admission into the B.Ed. Programme.
