Department of Economics, Dibrugarh University Conducted Socio-Economic Survey in the Erosion Affected Areas of Majuli, Assam


River bank erosion has been a perennial problem in the state of Assam, that affects the economic and social life of people living near the rivers in particular, and the economy of the state in general. In recognition of the severity of the issue, the Department of Economics, Dibrugarh University conducted a socio-economic survey in three of the erosion-affected areas, viz., Saalmora, Dakhinpaat, and Afalamukh, in the district of Majuli, Assam on October 13th, 2023. The programme included participation from all the students, teachers and research scholars of the Department. The survey was designed to gather information on various socio-economic and demographic aspects of the residents of the erosion-affected areas well as to provide the students of the department an exposure to collecting and working with primary data as a part of a regular academic exercise.
